CENTRA AND LIFEPOINT HEALTH PARTNER FOR MAJOR SIMON'S RUN MEDICAL DEVELOPMENT

Centra Health met with Campbell County staff in March to discuss their plan to construct a specialty medical campus on property Centra acquired in Simon's Run. The facilities will include a 75,000 sf therapeutic behavioral health hospital providing inpatient services and a full-servic10e 50-bed inpatient acute rehabilitation facility. Centra Health has partnered with Lifepoint Health to offer these facilities, filling a significant community need. Construction is expected to to be completed and open for business by 2025.

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPROVE GAS EXTENSION TO INDUSTRIAL HUB IN TIMBERLAKE AREA

In March, the Board of Supervisors voted to approve funding in the amount of \$97,770.38 for a natural gas extension to serve the industrial hub on Crowell Lane. In early 2022, Economic Development recognized the opportunity to extend natural gas service down Crowell Lane while pursuing the extension to the new Chick-Fil-A location. Staff connected with three businesses on Crowell Lane that plan to use natural gas for their operations as soon as it is available: Clubhouse Bar & Grill, Lynchburg Powder Coating, and Industrial Plating Corporation. These businesses will be committing to connecting to the gas line within one year of its availability. A timeline for the project will be determined once the connection agreements are signed and

returned.

Natural gas availability can be a makeor-break requirement for incoming or expanding industrial developments, so Economic Development will use this infrastructure improvement as a tool to attract prospective employers for any future economic development in the Crowell Lane area.
