BWXT-LED TEAM AWARDED LARGEST SINGLE CONTRACT IN COMPANY'S HISTORY

The US Department of Energy (DOE) has announced a joint venture led by BWX Technologies, Inc. has been awarded a contract with an estimated value of up to \$45 billion, over a 10-year ordering period, for environmental management operations at the Hanford Site in Washington State.

"This is the largest single contract award in our company's history and is a stair-step achievement as we strengthen our leadership position in environmental restoration at highly technical projects across the nation," said Rex Geveden, BWXT's president and chief executive officer.
