AEP OFFERING CASH INCENTIVES FOR SMALL BUSINESS ENERGY EFFICIENCY IMPROVEMENTS

Businesses can receive up to \$25,000 each for lighting and non-lighting projects, for a total of \$50,000. Lighting projects can include LED exit signs, recessed lighting, pin-based lamps, troffers and retrofit kits, high and low bay luminaires, linear lamps, controls, refrigerated case lighting and delamping. Non-lighting projects can include energy efficient upgrades to commercial equipment including refrigeration and kitchen equipment, air compressors, variable frequency drives and HVAC.
