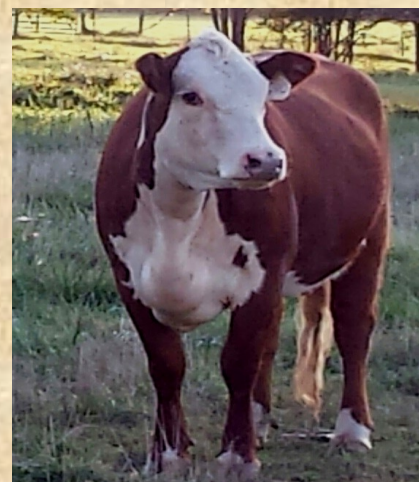

Melrose Bison Farm



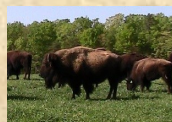

Sans Soucy Vineyards



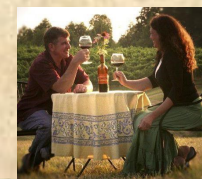

The vines include a combination of Bordeaux, Alsatian, and Rhone varietals with a few experimental rows planted to discover what might yield the best results. In 2004, an additional 1 acre of Tempranillo, a Spanish grape which thrives in clay soil, were planted. We have several monthly events and our annual Shrimp & Wine Fest.
