2022 BROOKNEAL STRIPED BASS TOURNAMENT

RULES & REGULATIONS:

- Tournament shall begin at 8pm Friday, April 22nd and end Sunday, April 24th at 2pm. <u>REGISTRATION MUST BE MADE PRIOR</u> <u>TO</u> 8pm on FRIDAY, April 22, 2022. On-site riverfront registration will be held at the Brookneal Boat Landing from 11am on Friday, April 22nd until the tournament begins at 8pm. <u>NO ONE WILL BE REGISTERED AFTER 8pm</u>. Children under the age of twelve (12) may fish with their parents without being registered in the tournament. However, <u>THEY WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR PRIZE MONEY</u>.
- All Virginia Game & Inland Fisheries regulations must be followed.
- Continuous weigh-ins will take place at the Brookneal Boat Landing throughout the Tournament with the final awards being made at 2:15pm on Sunday, April 24th. <u>ALL FISH MUST BE WEIGHED NO LATER THAN 2pm on SUNDAY, April 24th</u>. No culling of striped bass is allowed during the Tournament unless the fish are released immediately after being caught.
- The largest single striper caught and weighed prior to 2pm on Sunday, April 24th will be declared the winning fish. In the case of a tie, the earliest fish checked in will be declared the winning fish. Each fisherman is only eligible to win one place regardless of the number of fish weighed.
- Fishing is limited to the area between Leesville Dam and the intersection of Difficult Creek and the Staunton River.
- The Tournament Committee reserves the right to inspect any and all fish, maintains the right to disqualify any participant for violations of the Tournament Rules and may request a polygraph test. Tournament caught fish will also be made available to the Department of Game & Inland Fisheries personnel for data collection upon their request.
- Any protest of the Tournament must be in writing to the Tournament Committee by 2:15pm on Sunday, April 24, 2022.
- Any registered entrant fishing in a boat with an unregistered fisherman shall be disqualified. All winning entries will be subject to certification by the Brookneal Striped Bass Tournament Committee.
